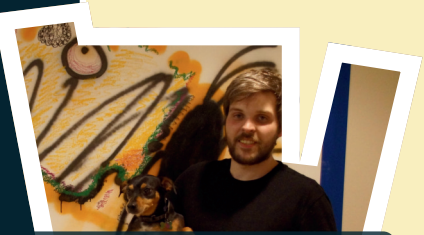

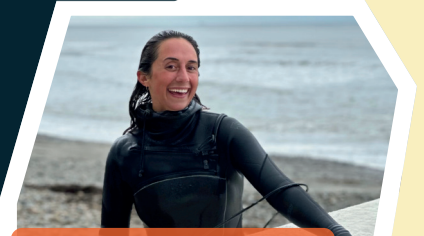

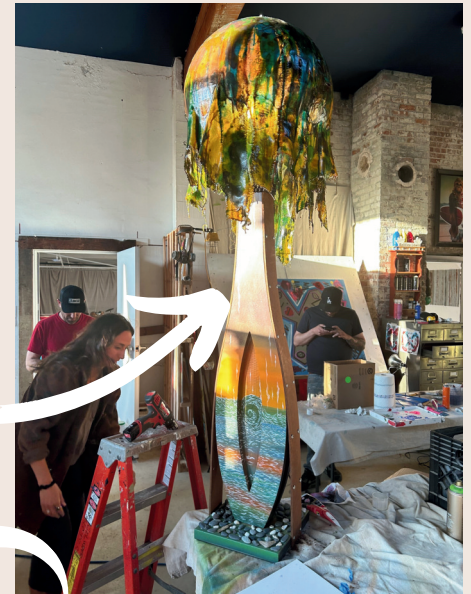
New Original Works by Resident Artists
